1. Trophy party is June 13, 2010. Bring goodies!

2. I recommend that each traveling team coach coordinate a scrimmage with an appropriately aged Rec. team so that Rec. parents can get introduced to the travel side and so that travel coaches can see potential players from Rec.
3. Cancellation and Rescheduling rules... If any coach needs to cancel/reschedule a game, you MUST do two things: One – Inform your opposite coach of your needs no less than three days prior to the game. Realistically, you need to have this done no less than a week before. Two – (for Div II and III only) Inform Jason or myself no less than three days prior to the change so that we can inform our paid referees about the change. Your teams will be responsible for Ref fees if you do not inform us prior to the cancellation. We should also be informed about the rescheduled game no less than three days prior to the start of the game.
4. UK Elite is going well after we combined all teams in Div II and III.
5. Starting in the Fall, I will only place jersey orders once a week.
6. Anyone need equipment or ice packs?
7. The website is being changed and should be brand new for the Fall season. I need help with this. Anyone with HTML/website experience is needed.
8. UK Elite Summer camp is July 26th Thru July 30th. Price is \$155. I am waiting to hear about group discounts.
9. I want to expand all Divisions by at least one team to bring the team numbers down.
10. Along with the expansion, I think it would be a great idea for every team to play under the lights during a night/evening game.
11. I have already worked out game rotations for five teams divisions with all teams playing 12 games over 10 weeks. In order to accomplish this, I need all coaches to identify and recruit head coaches for the Fall.
12. I heard a lot of feedback that parents were upset that they didn't find out about Picture Day until the week pictures were to be taken. I sent the schedule to everyone via email April 16th. Coaches should try and pass on information to parents/players as soon as possible.
13. Here are copies of the new, clarified Mercy rules. We will add this to the website.

Mercy Rule

1. When a team has a six goal lead, the losing team may add a player. In the case of full sided games (11 vs 11), the winning team should remove a player.
 2. If the losing team scores a goal to bring the lead down to five, the removed player may be replaced (or the added player must be removed).
 3. When a team has a seven goal lead, the losing team may add a second player (or the winning team must remove a second player). In addition to the seven point lead, the winning team should attempt to complete, at a minimum, two good clean passes before attempting a shot on goal.
 4. If the losing team scores a goal to bring the lead down to six, the second added player must be removed (or one removed player may be added back).
- Clause ad infinitum. In the case that the winning team continues to score beyond the seven goal lead, continue to add imaginative and increasingly difficult conditions to the winning team's goal scoring opportunities.
